

**Regulations of “Swisschamber Card” Discount Program  
of the Polish-Swiss Chamber of Commerce**

§ 1. General provisions

1.1 The Program shall operate under the name “Swisschamber Card”

1.2 The organiser of the Program is the Polish-Swiss Chamber of Commerce with its registered office in Warsaw, Al. Niepodległości 69, entered into the Commercial Register kept by the District Court of the Capital City of Warsaw, 12th Business Division, KRS 0000157319.

1.3 Offer of the Partner of the Program, company’s website and information concerning the Card are available at the website [www.swisschamber.pl](http://www.swisschamber.pl). Information on hotels participating in the Discount Program of the Chamber are available at the website of the Chamber and Partner of the Program.

1.4 The Program commences on 3rd February 2011 and runs until further notice.

§ 2. Rules for participation in the Program

2.1 Persons who have received a Discount Card of the Polish-Swiss Chamber of Commerce may participate in the Discount Program.

2.2 The Swisschamber Card, hereinafter referred to as the Card, is issued by the Polish-Swiss Chamber of Commerce. Member companies of the Chamber may buy the Card as a gift for persons to whom they wish to give it.

The Card is personal and valid for a period of one year from the date of issue.

The total cost of buying the Card amounts to:

440 PLN (net price) in case of electronic version, used on a mobile device (application available for download at: <http://www.bsclub.pl/pl/mobi.html>),

490 PLN (net price) in case of plastic version.

To order the Discount Card, please contact the office of the Chamber.

2.3 The Card is not a credit card, not a cash card and not a debit card.

§ 3. Partner of the Program

Business Saving Club (further referred to as „BSC”) offers up to 50% discounts on the price of the day on accommodation in hotels in Poland and abroad. The list of hotels is available at the website [www.bsclub.pl/pl/hotele.html](http://www.bsclub.pl/pl/hotele.html); BSC reserves the right to modify the list at anytime.

#### § 4. Usage of the Card

4.1 The Card may only be used by the person for whom it has been issued.

#### 4.2 Reservations

In order to benefit from the discount on accommodation in hotels participating in the Program, please contact Customer Service (hotline: 0801 146 839). Cardholders should introduce themselves as BSC club members and make a reservation for a room. After the hotel confirms the reservation and after the membership card has been presented at the check in, a discount on accommodation will be given automatically.

The BSC reservations department is available from Monday to Friday from 8:00 am to 8:00 pm. Reservations should be made at least 48 hours in advance.

The discount covers both hotels in Poland and worldwide.

4.3 Hotel has the right to ask the guest to present their Card in its plastic or electronic form.

#### § 5. Final provisions

5.1 The Polish-Swiss Chamber of Commerce reserves the right to make changes to these Regulations at any time, provided that the intention of those changes is to improve the operation of the Program and when it is essential to increase the effectiveness of the Program and to achieve the objectives for which the Program was created.
