As we already have history of the data, it is easily to observe trends on labour market related to benefits' development, recruitment trends, internal and external policies, employer branding and salaries movement.


This year's edition has been also very special and exceptional due to Covid-19 pandemic outbreak. We can see how the companies are adapting to the ongoing changes.



Percentage of the total employed persons



Benefits reduction


Companies has been gradual <u>reducing</u> provided benefits.

Summary

Short conclusions after Human Capial Practices Survey:

- Transition from employment contracts to B2B contracts.
- Gradual reduction of benefits.
- Company cars are increasingly rarely offered in companies.
- Surprisingly not many companies have made use of the anti-crisis shield.
- Lower predictable average salary increase than expected.
- Homeoffice work, flexible working hours and online activities for employees will stay with us also after pandemic.
